Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are writing to advise you that from this coming Monday (13th January), there will be a permanent one-way system in operation around campus between 0730 and 0830, Monday-Friday, during term time.

This will remain in place **every morning** in order to ensure a safe and smooth journey for all.

There will be signage in place to guide you and more detailed information on how to reach each Boarding House below.

Please be warned that there will also be roadworks taking place outside The Chequers Pub in Well from Monday (13th) until Friday (17th). During this time, a separate one-way system will be in place, operated by SGN. Traffic heading along Dippenhall Road will not be able to access Long Sutton via White Hill. Instead, motorists will be directed along Well Lane, via Lower Froyle and Copse Lane. This is likely to cause disruption and increased journey times. (We enclose a map below to illustrate the affected area). Please do not enter LWC via the West Gate as a result of these works. Instead, remain on Copse Lane and enter the College via the Main Gate.

We have taken the decision to introduce the LWC one-way system now, in order to try and minimise the disruption caused by these separate roadworks to the LWC and wider Long Sutton communities. It will remain in place to improve safe traffic flow.

One-Way System Guidance:

From Monday, entrance to the College between 0730 and 0830 should **only be via the Main Gates (RG29 1TA)**. We then ask you to exit the campus via Hyde Road or the West Gate.

From the Main Gate, your journey will vary depending on the House you are dropping off at.

For Gosden, Haygate, Hazelveare and Summerfield:

Please enter via the Main Gate. Once your children have been dropped off, continue along the main drive, in keeping with the flow of traffic. Turn right at the roundabout at the top of the drive and continue along the Cinder Track, with the Coach Park on your left. At the Hyde Road junction, turn right and exit via Hyde Road.

For School House

After entering via the Main Gate, please turn left at the roundabout. After drop-off, you should return to the roundabout, continuing straight ahead to exit via the Cinder Track and Hyde Road. Alternatively, you can use the drop-off zone located at the top of the main drive.

For Park and Sutton

Please enter using the Main Gate, turning right at the roundabout and continuing towards Hyde Road via the Cinder Track. At the Hyde Road junction, please turn left. This stretch of Hyde Road will remain two-way to allow for an easier exit, which you can make via the West Gate or the bottom of Hyde Road.

For Junior House

Having entered through the Main Gate, please turn right at the roundabout and continue towards Hyde Road via the Cinder Track. Once your children are dropped off, continue along Hyde Road and exit at the bottom.

Inevitably, traffic will be heavier than usual during this period each morning and as such, we ask that you allow extra time for your journey.

The speed limit remains 15mph across the site and 30mph through Long Sutton village. Please refrain from using handheld mobile devices whilst travelling.

Our priority is the safety of all on campus and we thank you for your continued support with this.

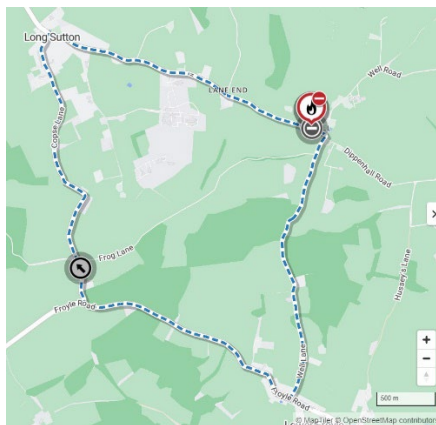


Illustration of roadworks & one-way system at The Chequers Pub, Well.
